Day 01: ... / Lima

- ✓ Arrival to Lima and transfer to selected hotel;

Day 02: Lima

- ✓ Sightseeing city tour of Lima and visit to Larco Museum;

- ✓ Transfer out for Trujillo flight, arrival and transfer to Trujillo hotel;
- ✓ Visit the Temples of Moche and admire the friezes at the Temple of the Dragon;
- ✓ See the famous boats known as caballitos de totora in the beach town of Huanchaco;
- ✓ Explore Chan Chan, the ancient capital of the Chimú civilization;





Day 04: Trujillo / Chiclayo

- ✓ On the way visit El Brujo Archeological Complex and Señora de Cao Museum;

Day 05: Chiclayo

- ✓ Visit Huaca Rajada, known for the discovery of the Lord of Sipan mummy;
- ✓ Tour Tucume, also known as The Valley of the Pyramids;
- ✓ Explore the Lord of Sipan Royal Tombs Museum to see Moche jewelry and other artifacts;

Day 06: Chiclayo / Cusco

- ✓ Transfer out for Cusco flight;
- ✓ Arrival and transfer to Cusco hotel;





Day 07: Cusco

- ✓ Sightseeing city tour of Cusco and visit Sacsayhuaman Archeological Park;

Day 08: Cusco / Sacred Valley / Cusco

- ✓ Full-day tour to the Sacred Valley of the Incas – Maras, Moray and Ollantaytambo;

Day 09: Cusco / Machu Picchu / Cusco

Day #1

Lima | Immerse in the colonial grandeur of Peru's capital, an oasis of culture and elegance in Spanish America

Arrive in Lima and transfer to selected hotel. Founded in 1535 by Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizarro, this "City of Kings" is a mélange of colonial structures, pre-Columbian sites, and modern conveniences. (No Meals)





Day #2

Lima| Exploring the capital, its colonial architecture, its array of historic monuments and its incredible museums

This morning explore the pre-Hispanic, colonial and modern highlights of Lima, visiting Huaca Pucllana or Huaca Huallamarca, pre-Colombian sites; the Plaza Mayor, which is the birthplace of the city of Lima, the beautiful Cathedral, built in the 16th century; and the masterpiece of San Francisco Monastery. Spend time exploring the Larco Museum, one of the city's best museums for pre-Columbian artifacts. (Breakfast)





Day #3

Trujillo| Known for its colorful colonial heritage, delicious food and ancient adobe pre inca temples

Morning flight to Trujillo, where spring lasts forever and its charm goes way beyond its pre-Hispanic and colonial past. Transfer to selected hotel and immediately you'll start enjoying your tour to Trujillo's most significant archeological site on a cultural full-day tour of the area's most atmospheric and astounding ruins. Explore the sacred structures of the Temples of Moche and the Temple of the Dragon; feast upon local specialties in the coastal town of Huanchaco; and discover South America's biggest ancient city at the UNESCO World Heritage site of Chan Chan. (Breakfast)



Day #4

Chiclayo| The mystery of the tattooed mummy, changed the concept of female power in the pre-Hispanic world

Today delve into the history of Peru's ancient Moche people visit El Brujo Archaeological Complex on your way to Chiclayo. Set out from Trujillo to this incredible site, where you'll get to see ancient ruins from the 1st to 8th centuries—the time with the Moche civilization thrived. Marvel at the site's three intricately decorated temples and explore its museum, where the recently excavated mummy Lady of Cao is on display. (Breakfast)



Day #5

Chiclayo| Kingdom of powerful lords, a trip to the past to get to know the glory of the Moche

Today you will learn about two ancient Peruvian cultures visiting related archeological sites on this day-long tour. First, you will visit Huaca Rajada, where archeologists discovered the Moche civilization's Lord of Sipan mummy in 1987. Then you'll also explore Tucume, an 8th-century site encompassing dozens of mounds and pyramids once belonging to the Sican culture. Finally, you'll visit the Lord of Sipán Royal Tombs Museum, home to Moche artifacts including jewelry and headdresses. (Breakfast, Lunch)



Day #6

Cusco | The capital of the Inca Empire;
Seductive, striking and natural, who's history
lives in its streets and squares

Morning flight to Cusco, the former ancient capital of the Inca Empire. Transfer to your selected hotel and take a time to acclimatize. (Breakfast)





Day #7

Cusco | Mix of Inca and Spanish architecture, burgeoning culinary scene and world class museums and Inca sites

Morning at your own leisure for relaxing and enjoying the atmosphere in its many squares and picturesque streets, or shopping traditional Peruvian handicrafts. Afternoon guided city tour of Cusco, including The Cathedral on the Plaza de Armas, the extraordinary Qoricancha (Temple of the Sun) and the fascinating Sacsayhuaman National Park, a testament to the Incan architectural skill which is compiled of massive stones. (Breakfast)



Day #8

Sacred Valley | Like a journey back in time; Living culture, captivating landscapes and isolated weaving villages

In the morning, you will explore Peru's historic Sacred Valley of the Incas, where time seems to stand still. Visit the Andean village of Chinchero. Visit the salt terraces of Maras to see and learn about an ancient pre-Incan method of producing salt. Visit the amazing circular terraces of Moray, an astonishing example of the agricultural skills used as an Incan laboratory to acclimatize crops. Continue to the town and fortress of Ollantaytambo, an astounding feat of construction and ingenuity which is considered a "Living Inca Town" as it is the only Inca settlement that has been continually inhabited since its inception. (Breakfast, Lunch)



Day #9

Machu Picchu | The Lost City, crown jewel of the Inca Empire and one of the new seven wonders of the world

Today you will enjoy a day trip to Machu Picchu, one of the new Seven Wonders of the World and the most spectacular sight on the South American continent. This spectacular journey through the Sacred Valley by narrow gauge railway to Machu Picchu Pueblo (former Aguas Calientes), the little town on the foot of the Inca citadel, is one of the world's great travel experiences. Machu Picchu, forever holds the secret of its passing, as its Incan inhabitants left no written records of its purpose or its flawless construction. Discover this renowned mountain-top Inca site with your guide, learning about its construction, history and what daily life was like for its residents. (Breakfast, Lunch)



Day #10

Cusco | Depart

Flight back to Lima and connection back home. End of services. (Breakfast)
